VINEYARDS	"Brenda's Vineyard", located in the Stag's Leap District lends a characteristic silky texture, grace and balance to the blend. The Stice Lane Vineyard located in the southern part of St. Helena produces wine with deep aromas of current and cassis, a thick viscous palate and rich tannins. Both vineyards consist of mainly older vines planted on well-drained, nicely balanced, valley floor vineyards.
